Abstract Guidelines

Oral and Poster Presentations

You are invited to submit an abstract for an oral or poster presentation on amphibian physiology, genetics, population dynamics, biogeography, malformations & contaminants, habitat protection & species at risk, and information gaps, or any other topic on Alaskan amphibians. Since the primary objective of the conference is to share information, preliminary results are acceptable. All submissions must be presented by one of the named authors on the abstract.

Oral presentations will be scheduled for 10, 20, or 30 minutes, including questions from the audience. Please indicate the predicted length of your talk when submitting your abstract. Also, please indicate your media needs – computer projector, slide projector, overheads, or video.

All abstracts must be received no later than **January 16, 2006**. Abstracts received after this date will not be included in the program. You will receive an email receipt of your abstract.

Please use the format shown and explained in the body of the sample abstract below. Use email to submit your abstract. Please submit the abstract as a Microsoft Word attachment using the following naming convention: last name of first author followed by ".doc", for example, "Hodge.doc". If you are the first author for multiple submissions, sequentially number each file, for example, "Hodge1.doc" and "Hodge2.doc". Email the abstract to david_tessler@fishgame.state.ak.us. Please use "AK Amphibian Conference 2006 abstract" as the subject line of the email.

Skip 2 lines and type the text of the abstract, single-spaced, Times New Roman font type.
